

some of the UN resolutions pertaining to Middle East/Palestine/Lebanon:

- 181 Nov. 29, 1947, recommends and plans the partition of Palestine with Jerusalem being established as a *corpus separatum* under international protection.
- 194 Dec. 11, 1948, call'd for repatriation or compensation by Israel of the Palestinian refugees at earliest date, "...refugees wishing to return to their homes and live in peace with their neighbours should be permitted to do so at the earliest practical date, and that compensation should be paid for the property of those choosing not to return and for loss of or damage to property which, under principles of international law or in equity, should be made good by the Governments or authorities responsible."
- 242 Nov. 22, 1967, Security Council call'd for recognition of every state in the area and withdrawal of Israeli armed forces from "territories occupied in the recent conflict."
- 338 Oct. 22, 1973. Sec. Council res.
- 425 March 18, 1978, called for the full, immediate, complete and unconditional withdrawal of Israeli forces fr Lebanon and set up UNIFL (United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon). First Sec. Council res. not vetoed by the US condemning Israeli devastation of Lebanon and the killing of 20,00 civilians there in 1982.

- 660 Aug. 2, 1990, condemns Iraqi invasion of Kuwait, demands Iraqi withdrawal and calls for negotiation between the two.
- 661 Aug. 6, 1990, enacts trade embargo etc against Iraq.
- 662 Aug. 9, 1990, calls on all states not to recognize Iraq's annexation of Kuwait.
- 664 Aug. 18, 1990, demands Iraq to permit and facilitate the departure of nationals of third countries from Kuwait.
- 665 Aug. 25, 1990, demands the 'multi-national' forces to halt and inspect all ships coming and going to Kuwait and to verify their cargoes re: 660 etc and arms.
- 666 Sept. 3, 1990, directs the ICRC etc to provide foodstuffs as needed in Kuwait and Iraq.
- 667 Sept. 16, 1990, demands release of foreign nationals by Iraq and demands their safety.
- 669 Sept. 24, 1990, entrusts a committee to deal with requests for assistance under Article 50.
- 670 Sept. 25, 1990, condemns Iraq's continuing occupation of Kuwait and their treatment of Kuwaiti people and property, reinforces air and sea embargo.
- 672 October 12, 1990, calls upon Israel to abide scrupulously by the 4th Geneva Convention in regards to the Occupied Territories and expresses alarm at the massacre of Palestinians by Israeli forces at the Al Haram Al Shareef and other holy places of Jerusalem.
- 673 October 24, 1990, Expressed alarm at the Israeli Gov't's rejection of res. 672 and its refusal to accept the mission of the Sec't General.
- 674 Oct. 29, 1990, further demands against Iraq, re: hostages and foreign and Kuwati nationals.
- 677 November 28, 1990, deals with the demographic records of Kuwait & their destruction by Iraq.
- 678 November 29, 1990, allows one final opportunity for Iraq to comply with previous resolutions and authorizes the use of all necessary means to uphold and implement resolution 660 etc.
- 681 December 20, 1990, condemns the Israeli occupying forces' deportation of Palestinian civilians.

799 Calling for the repatriation of hundreds of Palestinian civilians, deported to South Lebanon from the (Palestinian) territories occupied by Israel since 1967, including Jerusalem.
803 renewing the UNIFIL mandate for another six months and re-emphasizes the previous resolutions regarding Lebanon.
806 February 1993, Sanctions against Iraq.
833 May 27, 1993, on the international boundary between Iraq & Kuwait.
852 renewing the UNIFIL mandate for another six months and re-emphasizes the previous resolutions regarding Lebanon.
986 U.S. intends to end the sanctions until its political and economic purposes are satisfied. The Security Council has been subjected every two months for the past several years to scurrilous and false attacks on Iraq by the U.S. to justify continuing the sanctions. Resolution 986, which the U. S. uses both to delay all relief and to control any relief authorized to assure a continuing, if slower, death and deterioration in Iraq, cannot justify continuing the sanctions another day.
2253 July 4, 1967, calls Israel to rescind all measures taken against the status of Jerusalem.
2254 July 14, 1967, condemns Israel for noncompliance with resolution 2253.
2341 Dec. 19, 1967, directs and thanks UNRWA, and notes with deep regret the non-settlement of the Palestinian refugees.
2649 Gen. assembly res. affirm'g the legitimacy of the struggle of people under colonial rule & alien domination & self-determination, entitled to restore their rights by any means at their disposal.
3236 Gen. assembly, Nov. 22, 1974, calling for recognition of the inalienable Palestinian rights.
